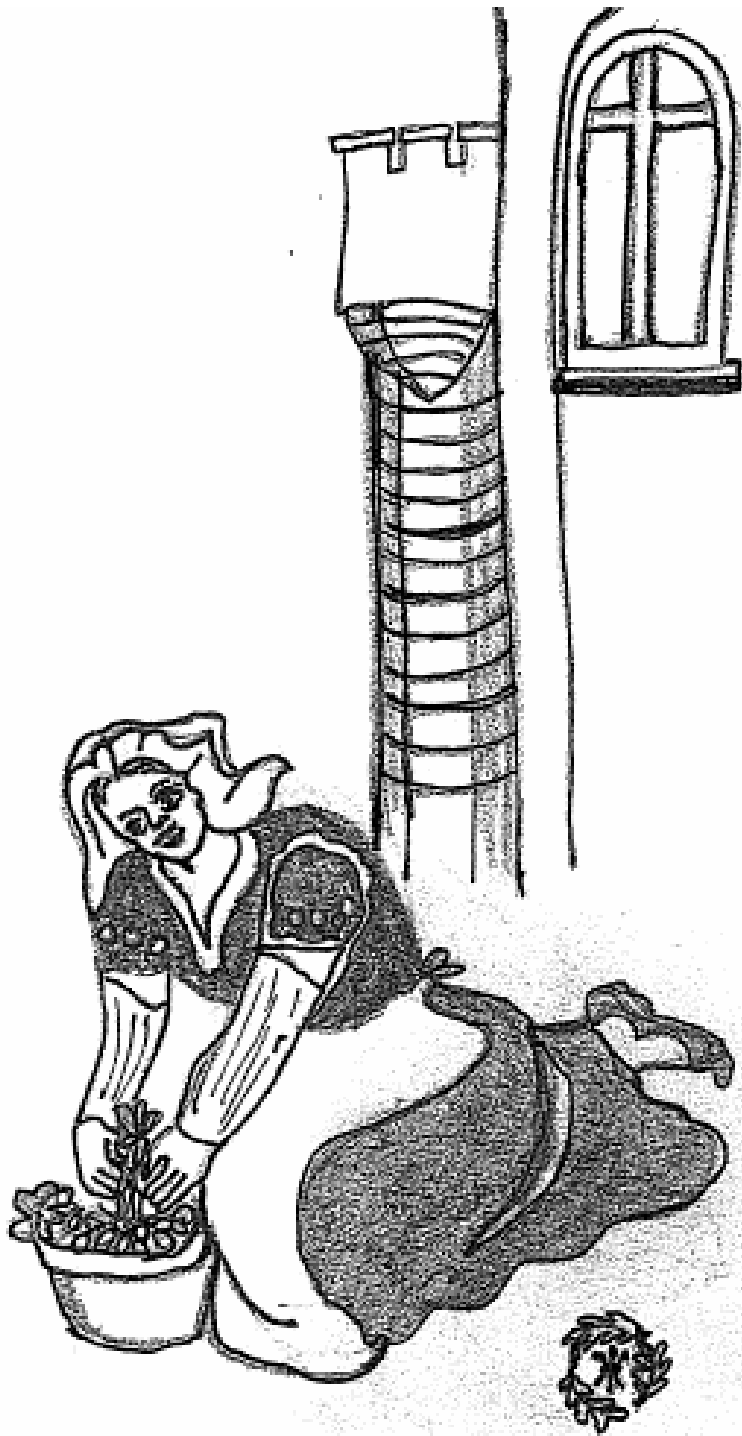

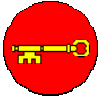

As the Solstice approaches and the days grow shorter, I hope that the season will bring each of you the opportunity to spend time with friends and family in celebration.

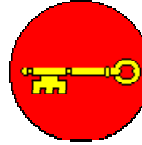

At the first traffic light turn Right onto York St. There is a BB & T bank, a liquor store and a Mexican convenience store at this intersection. Minutes from the Bright Hills Baronial Meeting
October 21, 2007

The meeting was called to order at 4:15 p.m. by Mistress Jeanne Tenneur de Bec. There were 20 gentles in attendance.

Chatelaine: Lady Yseulte Trevelyn was not in attendance but she e-mailed her report to the officers' list. Lady Yseulte reported that we have, in the last few months, seen many newcomers and SCA returnees check us out, and you have all been wonderful hosts! The flood has slowed a little of late, she is happy to report that many of our newcomers are still with us. It's such a pleasure to have so many talented people willing to share their enthusiasm and knowledge with new folk. Keep it up!

Chronicler: Lady Taira no Akiyo reported that she had found a replacement. She talked to Nicola, Baroness Roana friend, at TnT. Nicola has expressed interest in taking over the office of Chronicler. She is a professional editor. Lady Akiyo has asked her to attend the next business meeting before making her final decision. If Nicola decides to take over the office, Lady Akiyo will finish out this quarter and Nicola will assume the duties beginning with the January 2008 issue. This will give them time to get Nicola's warrant approved. Lady Akiyo will be Nicola's deputy for a few months in case she has any questions or problems.

Baron Temur asked if we were using the software purchased by the Barony. Lady Akiyo responded that she was using her personal software and she had not received software when she stepped up as Chronicler. She said that she would check with the previous Chroniclers. Lady Danielle said that she had not received software either. The officers discussed possibly getting an upgrade or buying a new program and decided to revisit this once the office has changed hands. Baroness Chagan expressed her concerns about people who have not been overly active with the group becoming officers. Nicola said that she has taken care of her job problem so she will be able to be more active in the future.

Web Minister: Lady Brienna Llewellyn Lindsey was not in attendance but she e-mailed her report to the officers' list. Lady Brienna reported that she is working on revamping the web site. Some of the changes will not be noticeable to the user and it affects the underlying code/script.

Baroness Roana stated that she had talked to Lady Yseulte and that she has the receipt for the domain name registration. They plan to meet up and exchange the receipt soon.

Listkeeper: Lady Reyne Telarius was not in attendance and had nothing to report.

Exchequer: Baroness Roana de Laci reported that the Barony is solvent. She has received the bill for the camp and is trying to figure out how they came up with their totals. After reviewing the bill with the autocrat,

Baroness Roana stated that the bill was indeed correct and procured the necessary signatures to pay it. She also announced that Kingdom is discussing requiring that each group submit a yearly budget. Lord Magnus is taking over the office after the first quarter of next year.

Steward: Master Chirhart Blackstar was not in attendance but Mistress Jeanne reported that he said “we have stuff.”

A marshal's class was held at TnT, there are six new MiTs.

Heavy Marshall: Baron Heinrich will be staying on as deputy Knights Marshall. The armored combatants didn't fight. There was no winner so we still have prizes. They were given to Lord Graham to store until the next fighting event. Baron Heinrich will be going to Unevent and attending the marshal classes.

Archery Marshall: Lord Seamus McRay reported that archery at TnT was delayed and lightly attended due to the inclement weather, which held up the initial start everything. There were no accidents or injuries to report and the archers had a good time.

The archery shoot was based on a “Loony Tunes” theme which incorporated several short unknown distance targets, a short clout type shoot, an advancing clout, a quintain shoot, a pendulum shoot and several timed shoots. The new Bright Hills champion was Fearghus MacDomhnaill.

Several folks got the opportunity to play with the variety of mediums and experience the differences in workability and feel of them. She does believe she spied a few budding food artists! Thank you Jeanne and Cordelia for coming along with your toys!!

Last time, Dame Olwen put forth a link to a website and asked folks to look it over and try out a recipe from it and bring the written recipe from the site and their redaction of it. We had a few nice items brought along which we decided are keepers. I put forth the same challenge for the next meeting! Mistress Jeanne reported that Lord Bruce is moving forward on the menu for Baronial Birthday. The Cooks Guild was invited to take charge of the Known World Party at Gulf Wars. Baroness Roana stated that people traveling to Gulf Wars to work in the kitchen can deduct expenses, meals, & site fee down as a charitable contribution.

TAG/WAG/BAG: TAG will meet on Dec 23 at Lady Wynne's house. It will be a party so please bring food. Mistress Jeanne reported that the bards are keeping busy; they are getting a lot of recorder players. Baroness Martelle reported that Lord Luke is listed as 1 of only 200ish recorder makers in the world. He's going to start teaching how to make medieval woodwind instruments.

Worshipful Company of St. Matthias: Baroness Roana reported that they held a table at Holiday Faire, thanks to Lady Bob & Lady Ardis. They made a net of \$300. They also made a gift to of feast gear and a basket to newcomer Laine. Niccola is joining the guild. St. Matts will also be helping the archers with putting up the shed over Thanksgiving weekend at the Bowmen.

Armorer's Guild: Baron Heinrich reported that they have a new subject that they're approaching, Japanese armour. Lord William recently came back from Japan. His lady's armour is being re-fitted and they are making a new set for William.

New Business

Discussion of Funds Being Held: Baroness Roana reported that we have dedicated funds that we can't do anything with. There is money for the fighters and money for the guilds.
