Bright Hills Business Meeting Minutes November 15, 2009

The following gentles were in attendance: Maestra Barbara, Lady Faye de Trees, Lord Magnus McTaggart, Lady Wynne ferch Rhodri ap Hwyell, Lady Katarzyna Witkowska, Chagan Khulan Baghsi, Lord Alexander Fowler, Mistress Jeanne Tenneur de Bec, Baroness Martelle von Charlottenburg, Lady Yseulte Trevelyn, Baron Temur of the Kerait Baron Heinrich Kreiner, Lord Janyn Fletcher, Lord Godai Katsunaga

I. Officer reports:

A. Chatelaine: We have had several contacts from interested folks, as well as several folks returning to the SCA. No one from Odyssey School has re-contacted us about the demo.

B. Chronicler: Lady Faye reports that things are going smoothly.

C. Exchequer: Lord Magnus reports that we have money. The Barony is in good shape financially. TTNT was profitable. Lord Magnus recommended that we move \$1000 from the checking account to savings. After some discussion, it was moved, and seconded, that \$1000 be transferred to the savings account. The motion passed.

Due to Lord Magnus's decision to step down early, there is a heavy recruitment effort underway. If anyone knows of someone who might be interested in taking on this challenge please contact Lord Magnus or Mistress Bec as soon as possible.

Steward: Master Chirhart reports that we still have stuff. As always, those (especially event autocrats) desiring to use Baronial goods must contact him.

D. Herald: Lady Wynne reports that, the next consultation session will be held on Friday, 11/25. The Friday consults are going well. She is still waiting to hear about devices that were submitted at Pennsic. She has also been working on computer-generated promissory scrolls that can be hand colored, Thanks again to Lord Randver, for making the wonderful Court portfolio. If anyone is interested in becoming a warranted herald, please contact her.

E. Marshall: Lord Graham was not in attendance. Baron Temur reported that the martial activities at TTTNT went well. Apparently the turkey leg brawl was well received and plans are underway to include this in upcoming events. There were no incidents.

Rapier- No report. Due to scheduling difficulties, the rapier fighters in the barony are attending the Tuesday evening practice in Lochmere.

Archery- Archery continues. Sunday practices have been pretty active. In keeping with the Baronial motto (Always the Best from Bright Hills), the archers of the barony are going to teach the entire archery track at the next university.

F. MOAS- The office was transferred to Chagan Baghsi at TTNT. The arts are very active in the Barony. There continue to be a lot of classes at Friday practices. Chagan Baghsi reports that she has not yet received her warrant. Mistress Jeanne will follow up. She has been contacting the heads of the local guilds to look at organizing classes.

4. Clothiers- Classes continue, including the Burgundian dress, and making your own body double.

5. Cook's- The Cooks' Guild met on 11/8, at Lord Seamus's home, and discussed the menu for Baronial birthday. Lord Seamus and Lord Bruce will be in charge.

6. PAGE- PAGE is working on a period play, at the request of Her Excellency, Baroness Martelle. The play will also be presented at Day of Dance. Then they will return to more singing and playing. And then it will be time to take on Chalice again.

7. TAG- TAG did not meet in November. The next meeting will be December 5, opposite Unevent,

8. WAG- Lord Luke & Lord Owen provided a demo of the foot powered lathe at TTNT. meeting. They will be working on making wooden bowls. Watch the list for announcements.

9. St. Mathias- The sale at TTNT went well. The goods donated by Baroness Roana have all been sold or distributed and the funds transferred to the Barony.

G. MOL: Lord Hunter reports that TTNT went well. The rain waited until the events were done. The tavern brawl was well received.

H. Webminister: Milady Eithne stepped up at TTNT. She missed today's meeting due to car trouble. She has been reviewing the information on the Guilds section of the web site. Everything behind the scenes has been brought up to the standard.

I. Seneshal: The barony is busy and healthy. Information was distributed on the regalia project. We are still trying to recruit deputy 5

officers. Everything is running smoothly.

J. Baroness: The baronial road show is on hiatus until January, except for Unevent. TTNT was a fun event. There were lots of activities and everything went smoothly.

Her Excellency reminds everyone to send in your cards and letters of recommendation for awards.

We are hoping to get more bids on the regalia project.

II. Old Business:

A. TTnT- Lady Yseulte reports that the event went well. We made over \$800. The children made \$30 for the Kingdom Travel Fund. The Scouts are happy with us. Thanks everyone.

B. Day of Dance- 12th Night- The event will be held at Lady Wynne's church. All other preparations are well underway. This will be a pot luck meal. The format will be similar to last year – Bardic interspersed with dance. The flyer needs to be posted to the list, and to the web site.

C. Baronial Birthday- Lady Faye has updated the bid to add the MIC (Lady Swieczka). A tavern brawl will be added. The Baronial Brewer competition will be held. She is still compiling event staff so let her know if you are interested in volunteering to help out, if you would like to sponsor a competition, or if you head a group that would be interested in hosting the fundraiser lunch.

D. list fence: Lord Graham was not present to report on the list fence. We need to get the receipts in before the end of the year.

E. Regalia- Her Excellency reported on this earlier. Mistress Jeanne will send a message to the list again.

F. Archery Project- There was an extended discussion amongst the officers regarding this proposal. Lord Janyn and Lord Godai were present to provide additional details. At the end of the discussion, it was moved and seconded that the barony approve the expenditure, and that the Archers will hold fund raisers, etc., and repay the barony at least half the amount approved.

III. New Business:

1. Kingdom Travel Fund

Her Excellency Martelle made a motion to contribute \$100 to the Kingdom Travel Fund, in honor of Their Majesties, since their presence contributed to the success of TTNT. The motion was passed,

2. Transfer of Regalia and Officer Inventory

3. Unevent

Mistress Jeanne needs to know who is going to make certain that all the officers' sessions are covered.
