Bright Hills Business Meeting Minutes December 21, 2008

In attendance: Bec, Faye, Katarzyna, Livi, Denis, Barb, Heinrich, Hunter, Brienna, Dawn W., Magnus, Carl, Martelle

Chatelaine: Unevent info on officers' page; there was a push to improve reporting of A&S and newcomer programs because all nonprofits are being scrutinized; that the SCA is a nonprofit *educational* organization was emphasized, so we need to be careful to present all that we are teaching (i.e., don't focus on fighting, as it does not keep our nonprofit status; A&S does); be specific about what is being taught and to whom; quarterly reports are now required from A&S rather than event reports; two or more missed A&S reports could result in the suspension of the group

Chronicler: putting together January issue (needs to be finished by next week); Unevent: reporting for Chronicler is one per year; the Yeoman counts as a report; chroniclers must now be at least 18 (because of money management issues); new revised form for annual report; Doomsday stuff is due 15 January; a hard copy is no longer required to kingdom local newsletter deputy; electronic issues should be archived on the website; when the royals change, they should be contacted about whether they preferred an electronic or hard copy; the populace must be notified when a newsletter is published; office should not be politicized, no negative comments, no taking sides, reprints require permission with a signature; recommended contacting people in pictures and NO pictures of minors; please send things into the Yeoman: fun stuff that we can share

Exchequer: we have about \$6500 in the accounts, which hasn't changed; we did get two things of note in December: this is the first month we will send a check to the church (\$300), and the barony has gotten a \$1000 donation, which I suggest should be put into the savings account so that the savings account is useful; a motion was made, seconded, and all were in favor; church donations will be made quarterly; Unevent: report filed quarterly with seneschal signature, bank statement, images of checks; request for warrant form needs to be signed by current seneschal; there must be an emergency financial committee, and this list must be included in reports, and must include seneschal, exchequer, and at least one other person; for ongoing expenses, include invoices in reports; as of April 1, there will be a new exchequer; branches will not supply water or sponsor the supplying of water;

a table may be provided, but water coolers and cups cannot be provided (due to laws regarding liability for supplying water); all hard copies of records must be kept for seven years

Herald: electronic report

Marshall:

Heavy: Unevent: the old marshall is stepping down, but a new one has not been chosen; if we have a melee at an event, the minimum number of marshalls on the field is at least 10%; no 10%, no melee; MICs at events are not being trained properly; if you are the MIC at any event regardless of discipline, you do not participate in the event except as MIC because there has been too much lax and problems

Archery: slower because of cold weather; began inter-kingdom seasonal shoots today

A&S: will be having a lampwork bead-making class at a Friday night practice (Friday after Baronial Birthday?); must be limited to six people; two classes at Day of Dance

Blacksmiths: no report

Brewers: Reyne submitted a report; planning a meeting at the end of January

Clothiers: Tudor classes are done (hopefully), but extended help is being offered on weekends and on Friday nights; we need to modify teaching style to make it more effective; we begin cycling beginner's classes again soon

Cooks: cooks met last week; next meeting is second Sunday in January (no location yet); pre-cook weekend prior to event for Birthday

Performing Arts: they have 12th Night music which they will be playing as well for Day of Dance

TAG: no report

Woodworkers: no report

Armors: Tuesday we are starting to cast medallions; forthcoming Met trip
MOL: Unevent: lots of changes there and just after: as of 1 Feb, 1) MOL

table will not be asking for membership card but will be asking for fighter cards, troll must catch everybody with sign-in/waiver 2) branches are not required to have an MOL, but fighting events must have an MOL; still do special waivers for equestrian and youth combat; almost every box on form has changed; no longer required to have fighter lists, so fighters must have fighter card or will not be able to fight or will have to re-authorize

Webminister: report on website; branches should use a web content management system to make it easier for other officers (e.g., chronicler) to put content on the web; the domain name will be owned and paid for by the kingdom

Seneschal: Unevent:

Waivers: troll will have to be more diligent that people sign in and sign waivers, and once checked in, do not have to sign/show waivers again (to alleviate long lines at MOL, which created issues at some events this year); royalty is not exempt from sign-in/waivers; hours must be posted for sign-in; a gentle reminder should be given that will escalate as the problem becomes chronic with individuals; the autocrat or seneschal has the right to require people to pay/sign in at troll or leave the event

Law Changes: a lot of clean-up; the difference between a group and a branch was clarified; a branch is an official part of the SCA, and groups may or may not be; a branch is a group, but a group is not necessarily a branch; changes to kingdom law is being made so that groups may host kingdom-level events to create more flexibility and opportunities for bids; all changes will be published in the February issue of the Acorn

Waterbearing: The SCA no longer supports or sponsors waterbearing; an official branch cannot sponsor waterbearing in any form, although volunteers can provide water and can solicit donations; feasts are not included in this for now

OLD BUSINESS

Day of Dance: the certificate was signed today and will be mailed on Monday; Lady Faye is the mistress of dance and has a program planned; Lady Yseulte is the Mistress of Bards, and bardic and dancing will alternate; Ingeborg has filled the maximum amount of merchants; no volunteers to watch the food tables and will be contacting Cooks about this; there is a

meeting on January 2 and, at the end of the meeting, will set up the hall for DoD

Birthday: everything is coming along; the major activity solidified is an A&S display for comment in preparation for KASF (personally invite Laurels and Laurels in the barony); a menu has been suggested; lunch will be a Cooks Guild fundraiser; will need to keep an eye on sign-in because of multiple entrances on all sides; should be in Jan and Feb Acorn; fighting is weather-dependent

KASF: moving along; a lot of offers of help at Unevent; insurance form has been sent, and check just needs to be sent

Baroness: nothing from Unevent because it was not scheduled; will be teaching two classes: naalbinding (16th) and Getting Blood from a Rock, or Surviving Documentation (23rd); will be going to 12th Night and two or three other events (including Day of Dance); send recommendations for awards because I have three courts over the next three months; also send recommendations to the Crown and are desperately looking for recommendations using online form or email them directly; working on baronial inventory; are short on all award tokens

Crescent Guard Event Proposal: have talked to Master Chirhart about lunch and feast; as far as I know, there is no conflict aside from Sapphire Joust and an event in the Carolinas; the archery community I've talked to don't seem to plan to go to Sapphire Joust; will also be promoting the event in the East Kingdom; have two possible trolls; event is unanimously approved; need to get on the kingdom calendar asap

Medallions: Because we are running so short on award medallions, I have an estimate to purchase blank medallions; they are \$5 each, up to 50, with \$10-12 for shipping, to provide a short-term solution for medallions that we need for upcoming events; proposal: purchase minimum amount of medallions to get the cheapest price (~\$275) for an emergency supply; seconded and approved

NEW BUSINESS

Drake has donated all Lady Ro's stuff to St. Matt's for a donation form; the total was about \$1700; a proposal was made to sign the form as tax-deductible donation; seconded and approved

Announcing New Swap Meet Nights!

Oyez, Oyez! Good Gentles with excess SCA goodies or those in need of SCA goodies, pray attend! The 2nd Friday of each month - barring special events such as Pennsic - will have an SCA Swap Meet at our practice site. This is an opportunity for those of us with too much SCA stuff to buy, sell, trade, swap or just haggle for other folks goods as well as a prime opportunity for our folks in need of SCA goods to acquire them via the same methods - buy, sell, trade, swap or haggle. ONLY SCA related goods, please.
